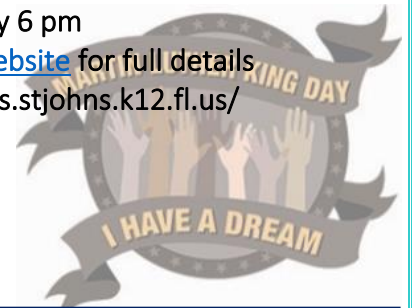
PASSPORT TO LEARNING
