Dear Mason Families-Thank you for a wonderful start of the school year!


The Front Office is a very busy place, especially this time of year. We appreciate your help in making our campus a safe and orderly place. Please help us by being receptive to the following school policies:

- Please drop-off students between 8am and 8:25am so they are in class on time
- For the safety of your student, tardy students must be walked into the Front Office by an adult
- Please pick-up students for Early Dismissal before 1:15pm on Wednesday/2:15pm any other day
- All adults on campus must have a photo ID
- All cars in "Parent Pick Up" should have their BLUE or ORANGE placard visible for staff and safety patrol
- All adults who volunteer or access campus must complete the School Access Form: http://stjohns.keepntrack.com/apply
- We need your help! We want to guarantee that every child arrives home the correct way every day. If you need to make a dismissal change for your student, please notify us by using the <u>DISMISSAL CHANGE FORM</u> located on the Otis A. Mason Website. Connect with your Child's Teacher:

OMES families, communication is so important. Please consider the following regarding communication with your child's teacher:

- Email is the primary and preferred method of communication for all teachers. Please reach out to your child's teacher at firstname.lastname@stjohns.k12.fl.us
- 2. Most teachers also use the **REMIND app** for text message communication.



- 3. *Do you have a Pre-K student?* Pre-K classrooms use **Class Dojo** for communication home.
- 4. Unless an appointment has been made in advance, teachers are not available to speak on the phone during the school day.
- 5. In-person conferences are a very important way to support your child and to communicate with the teacher. It is expected that parents meet with the teacher during in-take conferences. Your child's teacher will reach out to you soon to begin scheduling conferences. Please prioritize this very important meeting. We cannot wait to meet you!
