decide what the ballot will look like and then the Mason Staff will vote using what we

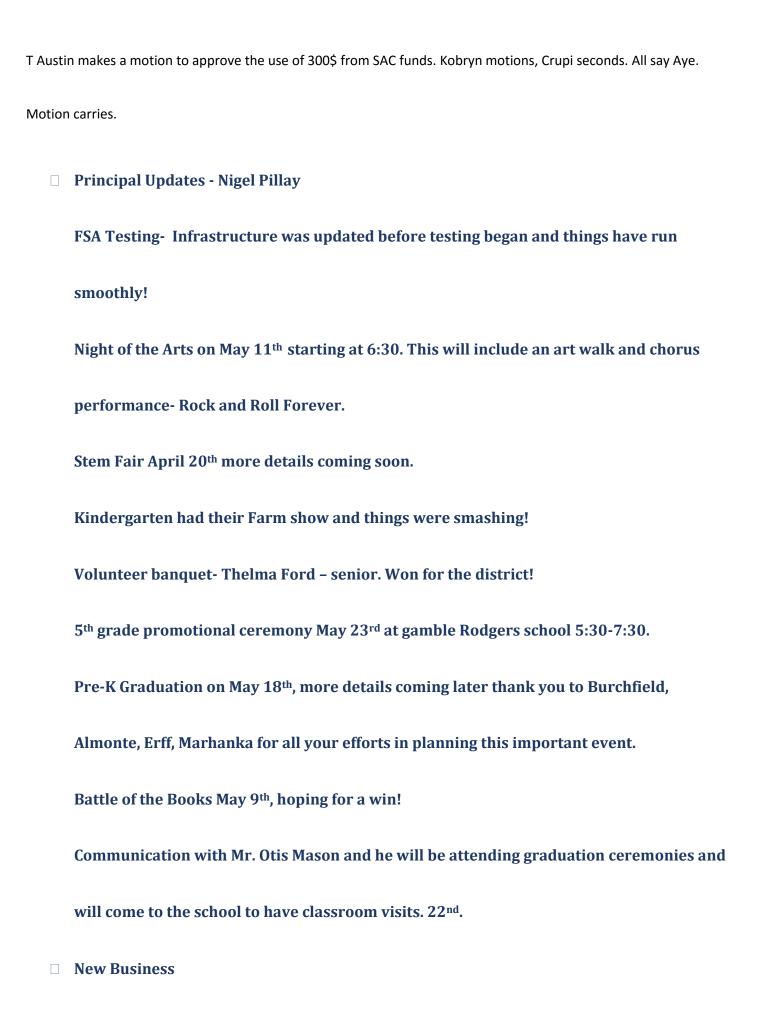
decide. Member discuss any necessary changes, including dates. T Austin calls for
