Returning Student Verification (RSV) Process –

Parents/guardians of all current students will receive an email from PowerSchool to complete the annual Returning Student Verification Form for the upcoming school year. The email will be sent to the parent/guardian listed as the first contact and will contain the link and instructions needed to complete the verification. This email will contain a special snapcode that will need to be used to complete the form. If you have children in multiple schools, you will receive a snapcode (a link) for each child. Snapcodes may be sent on different days depending on the school each child attends.

Please complete the verification form even if your child will not be returning to SJCSD.

Pre-K/VPK students will receive a different letter instructing them to complete a "New Student" form.

Parent Guide on Grading & Promotion –

Elementary Grading Guide

- Teachers will score assignments and provide feedback to students on a weekly basis therefore interim grades will not be issued.
- Students are accountable for engagement, participation, and completion of assignments

Students in K-2nd Grade

4th guarter marks for ELA & Math

- For identified ELA and math competencies, students will receive P for Progressing or I for Improvement Needed; remaining ELA and math competencies will not be graded
- M (Meeting the Standard) will not be used because of the challenge to observe students demonstrating skills for each competency. Therefore, marks will be limited to P or I for the 4th quarter.
- Improvement Needed will be reserved for students who meet one or more of the following
 - not progressing in 4th quarter
 - below grade level in 3rd quarter
 - o active tier 3 Rtl plan

4th quarter Science, Social Studies, Resource and Character/Social Development for K-2nd

 Feedback may be provided for science, social studies, resource, and character/social development skills lessons; however, no grade will be recorded on the report card

Students in 3rd-5th Grade

4th Quarter arades for 3rd - 5th

- For the fourth quarter, students will not receive traditional A-F letter grades on the report card. In ELA, math and science, students will receive P for Progressing or I for Improvement Needed for the 4th quarter grade.
- Improvement Needed will be reserved for students who meet one or more of the following:
 - o not progressing in quarter four
 - o below grade level in quarter 3
 - o active tier 3 Rtl plan
- Feedback may be provided for social studies, resource, and character/social development skills lessons; however, no grade will be recorded on the report card

3rd - 5th Report Card

• Final grades (A-F) for the school year will be calculated from grades in quarters 1, 2, 3.

Promotion K-5

Promotion decisions for students in grades K-5 will be made in consultation with parents, teachers, and school leaders based on the students' classroom performance and progress monitoring data. We will be holding meetings on Tuesday, May 19th to discuss students being considered for retention.

Grade 3 Promotion: Generally, the Grade 3 ELA FSA is a key component districts use to make promotion decisions. Since this data will not be available due to the cancellation of statewide assessments for the 2019-2020 school year, promotion decisions will be made in consultation with parents, teachers, and school leaders based on the students' classroom performance and progress monitoring data.

Student Pick-up & Drop-off of Materials/Say Good-bye -

On Tuesday, May 26th and Wednesday, May 27th, OMES will be open to collect some instructional materials from families (library books, borrowed items from the classroom, technology) and return any belongings that may have been left in the classroom. We will also be distributing yearbooks at this time. This is a great time to say good-bye to your teacher too! <u>Families with children in different grade-levels will need to come at EACH pick-up time.</u> We will not be able to accommodate multiple grade levels at a time.

5th Graders only need to bring: All of the items listed above, your borrowed copy of Tuck Everlasting, and any materials to be included in the 5th grade time capsule.

5th Graders only will receive: Promotion certificates, 5th Grade t-shirt, celebratory yard sign, yearbook (if ordered) and any items left in the classroom.

Pick-up and drop-off will be done in the PPU loop. Families will remain in their vehicles. Grade-levels will be assigned a time for distribution and pick-up (see below).
